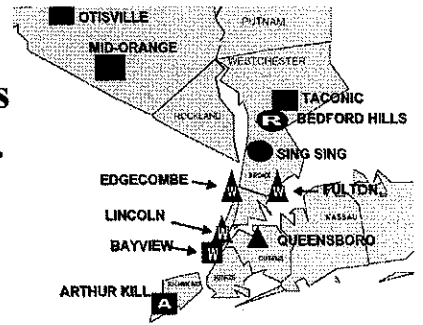

REMINDERS:

Each Organization must enter the Parade only from its designated Formation Street that is listed here and in the Official Program. No Organization is permitted to enter the Parade from the sidewalks of Fifth Avenue.

Organizations must line up between the above door numbers on the Street assigned and march in the sequence listed above. Only Organizations that have been invited to march and are affiliated with the Parade Committee are permitted to march or to display their banners. *This rule is strictly enforced.*

Please supervise the last row of marchers in your unit. **DO NOT ALLOW** "side-walk-stragglers" to fall in behind them. Any marcher exhibiting improper behavior will be removed. Do not attract unfavorable comments from the spectators and news reporters by allowing "undersirables" to join your ranks from the sidewalks while you are marching. Protect your good name
