NYSOOPBA LEGISLATIVE

1 AN ACT to amend the civil service law, in relation to extending t  
2 effectiveness of provisions establishing dispute resolution duri  
3 collective negotiations  
4

5 Became a law March 26, 2007, with the approval of the Governor.  
6 Passed by a majority vote, three-fifths being present.  
7

8 The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Asse  
9 bly, do enact as follows:

10 Section 1. Paragraph (d) of subdivision 4 of section 209 of the civ  
11 service law, as amended by chapter 30 of the laws of 2005, is amended  
12 read as follows:  
13

14 (d) The provisions of this subdivision shall expire [~~thirty~~] thirt  
15 two years from July first, nineteen hundred seventy-seven.

16 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, th  
17 the amendment to paragraph (d) of subdivision 4 of section 209 of t  
18 civil service law made by section one of this act shall expire on t  
19 same date as such subdivision expires.
