(Albany, NY) The President of New York States largest law enforcement union NYSCOPBA, issued an unprecedented message of urgency to all 25,000 members and their families today concerning the November 7, 2006 elections.

President Larry Flanagan stated, “As law enforcement officers, we can not support anyone who has broken the law. There is clearly some wrongdoing with what Comptroller Hevesi has done. As State employees we are constantly held to higher standards. Our members have had their share of negative experiences with Mr. Hevesi’s Office and with the recent findings by the state ethics committee, it is quite clear that NYSCOPBA has completely lost all faith in Mr. Hevesi as Comptroller and all trust as a fellow state employee”
