*Late Infantile NCL (Neuronal ceroid lipofuscinosis) begins between ages 2 and 4. Early signs are loss of muscle coordination and seizures along with mental deterioration and blindness. Afflicted children may show delays in speech development well before other symptoms appear. This form progresses rapidly and ends in death between ages 8 and 12.
