### Frequently Asked Questions Lieutenant's Examination

- When will it be held?
- Will it be four years from the original test date (June 2011) or will it be held in (January 2012), which is four years from the date the second half was given?

There is no test date set for the next Lieutenants exam. The list that we are currently promoting from is set to expire on April 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2012. This date is four years to the day that the test was certified and began to be utilized. I am including CSL 56 for your reference (see below), which clearly spells out the Department of Civil Service's ability to establish a new list prior to the four year expiration of the existing list or extend the current list if they deem appropriate. As soon as I receive a more definitive timetable from the Dept. of Civil Service, I will pass it along to you.

Duration	
CSL § 56 PR § 68.1	The Civil Service Law provides that the duration of an eligible list shall be not less than one year or more than four years. If a list has been in existence for one year or more, it shall terminate upon the establishment of an appropriate new list unless the old list is extended by action of the Department of Civil Service. Additionally, should a financial emergency restrict the filling of vacancies, the Department of Civil Service may, in its discretion, extend the duration of the list for a period equivalent to the length of the restriction. Once a list expires, it cannot be revived, nor can an individual whose name was on the expired list receive an appointment on that basis.
