Sergeant's test scoring – There have been some questions as to the method in which the sergeant's test is scored. This is the procedure;

Once the score of the test is determined (raw score), the points for seniority are added on (one point for every five years). If you scored a 92 on the exam and had 10 years in the department, you would then have a revised score of 94.

Raw score + seniority points = final score

Once your final score is determined you are then placed in a band or zone. A score of 94 would be placed in the 95 zone/band.

If you scored a 92 final score you would be placed in the 90 score zone/band, etc.

Once you are placed in a zone/band you would then receive your military credits if applicable.

A 95 score zone/band plus your military credits of 2.5 would put you at 97.5.

Finally, after all scores are reached, you are ranked in seniority order to determine promotional position.
