Union stands in support with community directly impacted by the recent mass shooting

Union urges other statewide labor organizations to join them in an effort to raise money to assist

Albany, NY – The New York State Correctional Officers & Police Benevolent Association, Inc. (NYSCOPBA) is donating \$10,000 to FeedMore WNY, an organization that is spearheading efforts to provide food to the community directly impacted by this weekend's horrific shooting in Buffalo. FeedMore WNY is the recent combination of two long-standing organizations, Meals on Wheels for Western New York and Food Bank of Western New York.
