NYSCOPBA Members from Attica Correctional Facility Donate to Local Charity & Hospitals

Members Donate \$5000 of Toys & Gifts

Attica , NY – Following a holiday tradition of giving to local charities, NYSCOPBA members from Attica Correctional Facility donated \$500 dollars to Camp Good Days & Special Times on Friday, December 16.

Camp Good Days provides residential camping programs at a beautiful recreational facility, located on the shores of Keuka Lake in Branchport, New York, additional recreational and support activities are offered year-round, in the Rochester, Buffalo, Ithaca & Syracuse areas for children with cancer and the entire family.

On Tuesday, December 20, NYSCOPBA members from Attica donated stuffed animals and toys worth \$5000 to Wyoming County Community Hospital in Warsaw and to United Memorial Medical Center in Batavia. Toys were handed out on every floor, emergency room and lobby of Children's Hospital. Two carts filled with toys were left and donated to the play rooms as well.

Additionally, toys were delivered and handed out to the children on the sixth floor at Roswell Cancer Institute. The overflow of toys were left and donated to the toy closet at Roswell Park for future patients.
