On Tuesday February 28, 2017 Greene County Deputy Sheriff Kevin M. Haverly died as the result of injuries suffered in an on-duty car accident on Route 23 in Ashland, NY.

Deputy Haverly had served with the Greene County Sheriff's Office since 2014, first as a Corrections Officer and then in his current position as a Deputy Sheriff. He is survived by his mother, fiancée, two sons, his daughter, two brothers, his sister and several aunts, uncles and cousins.

Off duty NYSDOCCS members are encouraged to attend the services. Available on duty staff may also attend so long as their attendance does not incur overtime. Uniform staff attending the services shall be in a Department issued Class "A" uniform as specified in Directive #3083, "Uniform/Equipment Issue and Appearance" to include the Garrison Cap and Ike Jacket.
