New York State Correctional Officers & Police Benevolent Association, Inc.

Pursuant to a letter of agreement dated December 28, 2016, and signed by David Viddivo, Treasurer of the New York State Correctional Officers & Police Benevolent Association, Inc., hereinafter referred to as “NYSCOPBA,” the American Arbitration Association, hereinafter referred to as the “Administrator,” agreed to conduct a Runoff Election of Officers.

Ballots were mailed to eligible voters on Wednesday, October 11, 2017. NYSCOPBA provided the Administrator with a list of persons who were eligible to vote. During the course of the election an additional One Hundred Thirteen (113) ballot packets were mailed at the request of NYSCOPBA members.

To be counted, ballots had to be received by the Administrator no later than 5:00 PM on Friday, November 10, 2017. The administrator received Seven Thousand Three Hundred Forty-Five (7,345) ballots prior to the deadline. Some ballots were set aside due to eligibility issues both before and after the count. A breakdown of the mailing and return is listed as follows:
