*** Major incident on Saturday 3/06/2019 at Green Haven CF. After breaking up a fight in the Keeplock Recreation yard, the Officers were attacked by inmates. A shot was fired from the Observation Tower. Injuries to staff were reported.

Fishkill CF - Received several complaints about the departments push against beard exemptions.

Green Haven - Major drug bust by the package room Officers. I've spoken with the Supt to ensure that Commendations are given to the Officers. I've also contacted Senator Harckham and Assemblyman Lalor to ask for a renewed push for the Secure Vendor Program.

Greene CF - There is an issue with Pre-Approved Sick requests being automatically denied. I've contacted Assistant Commissioner Kirkpatrick who stated that he will look into it. Still waiting for his response.

Hudson CF - There is a recent increase in throwing incidents. It seems as if the inmates are not being punished at all for their actions. Waiting on a full report from the Sector

Otisville CF - An issue was reported regarding the selection of staff to attend Fire & Safety Officer Training. I've reported the issue to Assistant Commissioner Griffen. Still waiting for his response.

Shawangunk CF - There are concerns regarding the placement of the J-Pay Kiosks due to the camera viewing area.

Sullivan CF - The rear gate Officer has again requested a closed circuit camera in order to view the rear gate entrance door. He cannot get a clear visual from his position prior to opening the door remotely.

DCJS is sending out letters to former members who have either resigned or retired pending an investigation. The letters are telling the members that their Peace Officer Status as reported to their system has been revoked by DOCCS due to employee misconduct. The Attorneys have been informed.

We had an issue with the way interrogations are being conducted with OSI and Labor Relations. A letter regarding the complaint was sent to Deputy Commissioner Martuscello and OSI Director Stephen Maher. Still waiting on the response.
