

Female Inmate Throws Feces on Officers

Incident Occurred During an Inmate Escort

Bedford Hills, NY – Two correction officers were struck by a brown liquid that was thrown by an inmate from her cell while the officers were escorting another inmate at the maximum security female prison.

The incident occurred on Monday, February 10 at approximately 12:36 p.m. The two officers were escorting an inmate to an afternoon program when both were struck all over the body and face with a brown liquid that apparently contained feces.

Both officers were treated for exposure and minor injuries in the incident.

The inmate, who recently was returned to the facility after violation parole, is serving a five year sentence after being convicted in Bronx County in 2017 for Assault 1st.

The investigation is on-going.
