Re. New York State Correctional Employees Use of Personal Protection Equipment

Dear Governor Cuomo and Acting Commissioner Annucci:

The uniformed members of the Department of Corrections and Community Supervision (DOCCS), specifically correctional officers, supervisors and parole officers, provide an essential public protection service to New Yorkers. The designated duties of these officials, by design, require close contact with inmates and persons previously incarcerated. As we continue to try to reduce the viral spread of COVID-19, it is incumbent that DOCCS permit these front-line law enforcement officers the ability to use basic personal protection equipment while on-duty.

Unfortunately, over 60 DOCCS employees, including the president of the union representing the State's correctional officers, have tested positive for COVID-19. Authorizing the use of N-95 masks, gloves and disposable smocks will protect both said officers and, importantly, the inmates and those on parole from potential infection.
